

## MINISTERS OF PRAYER

1. Every minister of prayer is committed to spending one hour a month before the Blessed Sacrament praying for **the good of the parish, our parishioners and specific prayer requests**.
2. The schedule is set up on a 28-day rotation, so you are scheduled for **the same day every 28 days**. The weekly schedule will be published in the bulletin.
3. So that you know, the door to the Blessed Sacrament chapel is **open 24 hours a day, seven days a week** -- it's never locked. (The chapel has its own outside door at the very back of the building. Its glass & metal construction makes it look like the entrance doors in the front.) This means you can fulfill your commitment any time during your scheduled day.
4. If circumstances make it impossible for you to come on the scheduled day, come on a different day. Normally we have a calendar for people to sign in but due to our being in the Day Chapel we will not sign in at this time.
5. The basket with the prayer requests will be placed at the foot of the tabernacle. Take a few out when you come to fulfill your commitment. When you leave, take the requests with you and continue to remember them in your prayer until you return.
6. Your prayer can take any form that is comfortable to you: the rosary, Scriptural prayer, spontaneous prayer, prayers from a book, etc. You do not need to keep repeating the requests. They are simply your special intentions during the prayer time.
